The QRDA Championship Pointscore rewards consistency and finishes and is based on the following format:

**1<sup>st</sup> Place – 25 Points, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place – 24 Points..... 25<sup>th</sup> Place – 1 Point.** If you do not finish a race, you score **0 Points**.

The QRDA Club Champion is determined by dividing your Total Points by the Number of Races held for your category throughout the racing season.

In 2017, Shane Hart in his Mazda RX7 13B Turbo Sports Sedan won both his QRDA Sports Sedan Club Championship and the Overall QRDA Club Championship Trophies, averaging a staggering 24.83 Points Per Race (out of a possible 25!)
